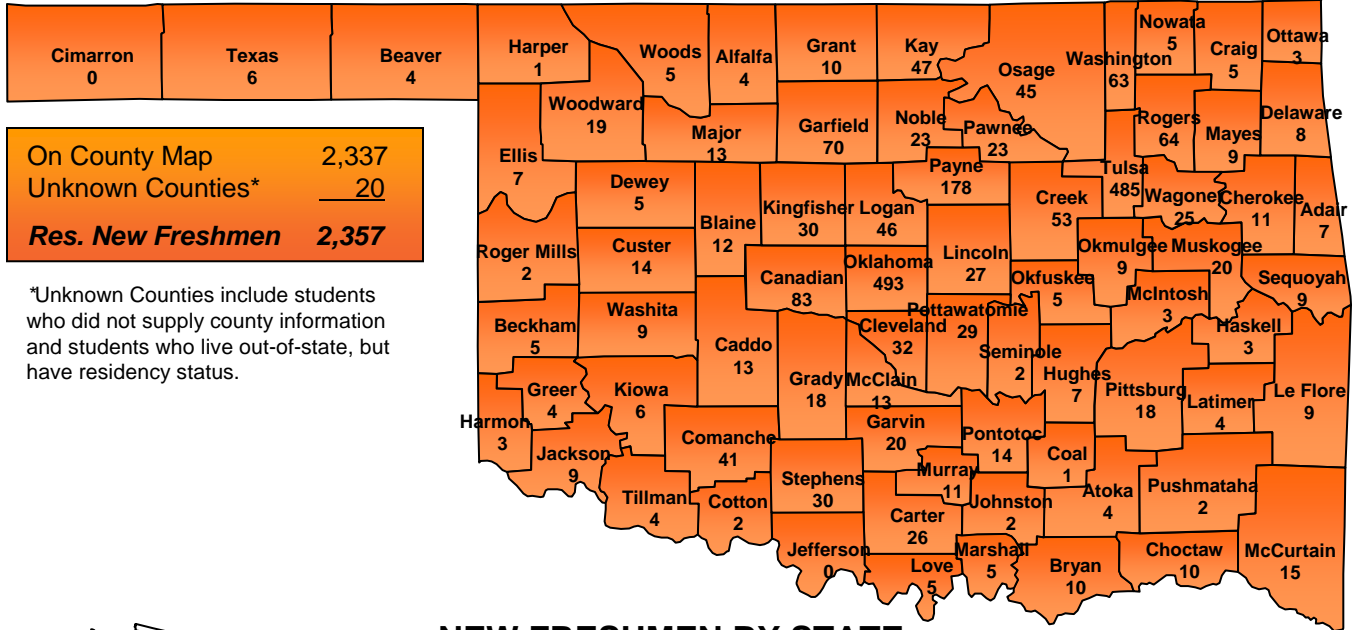


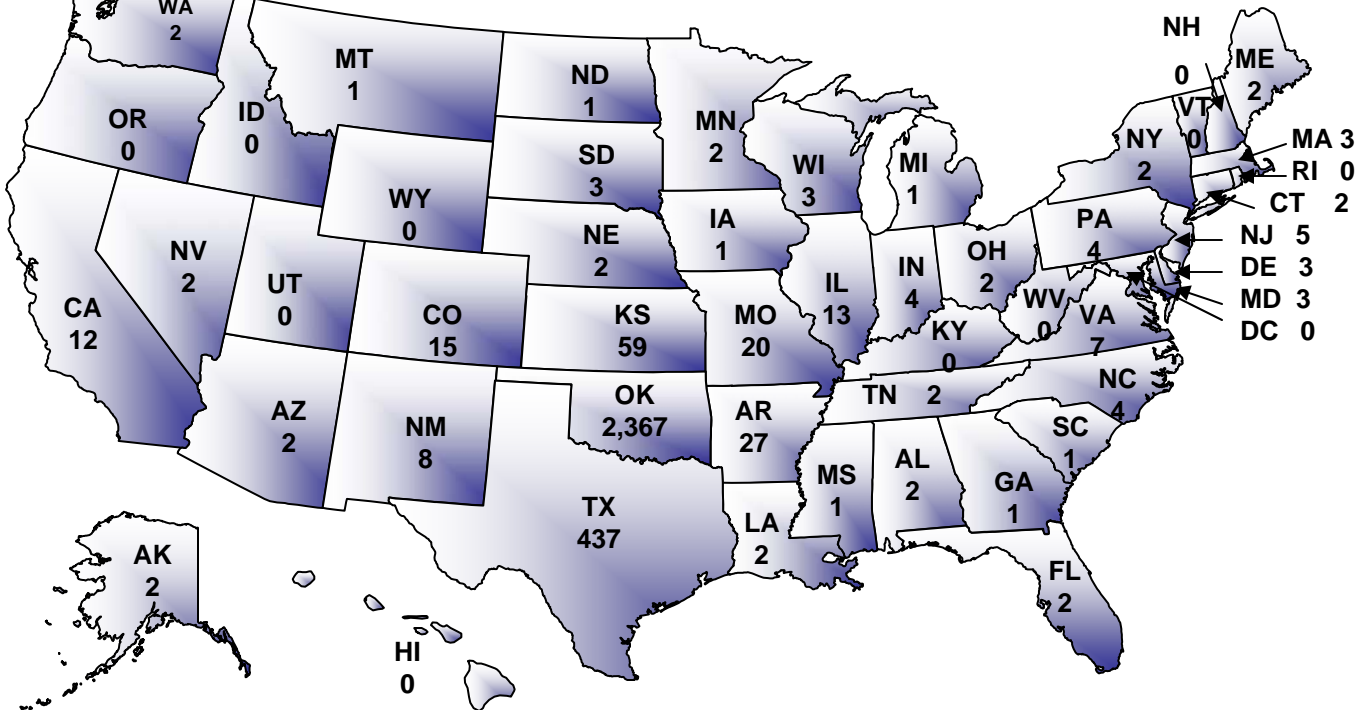

RESIDENT NEW FRESHMEN BY COUNTY



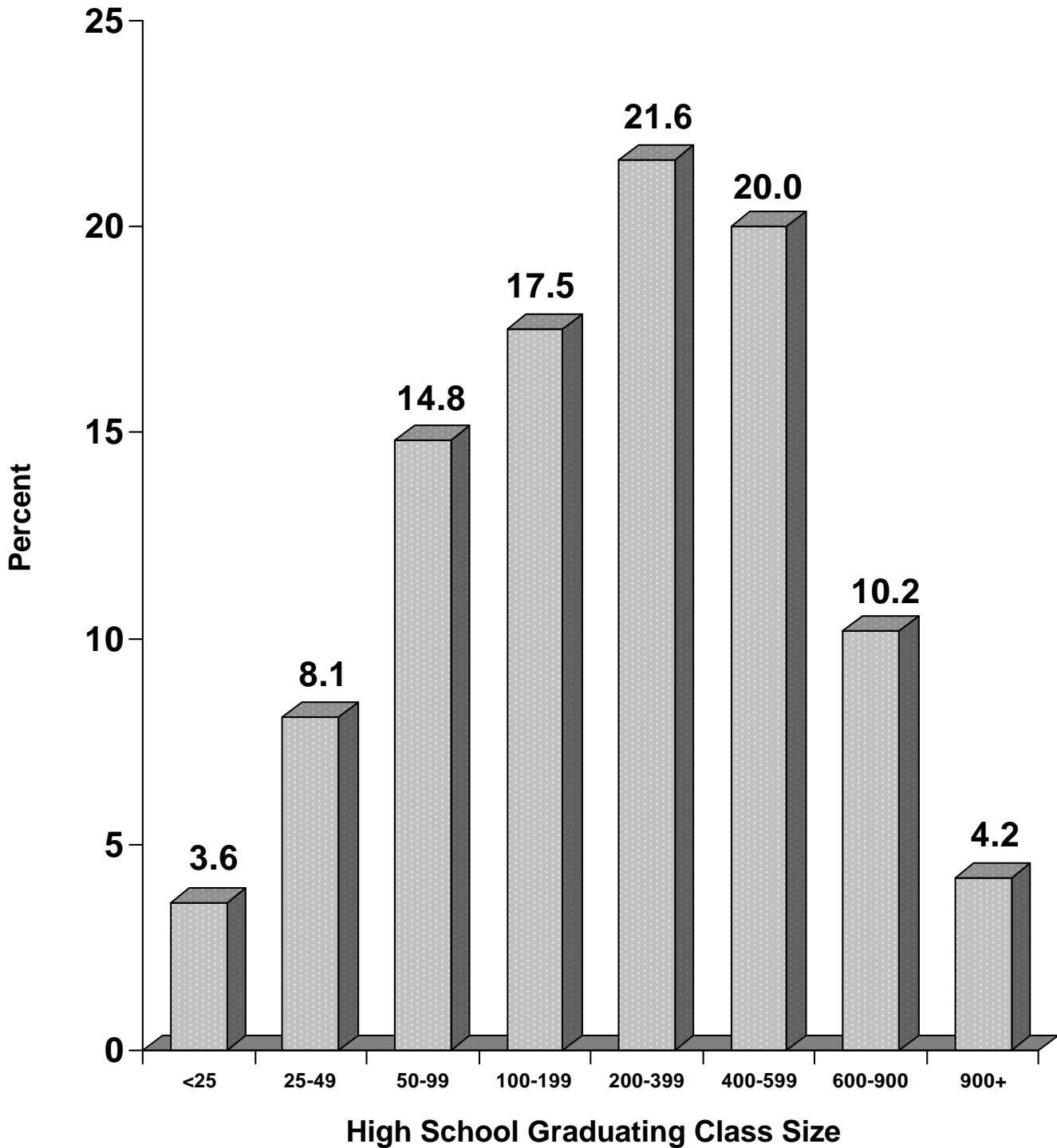

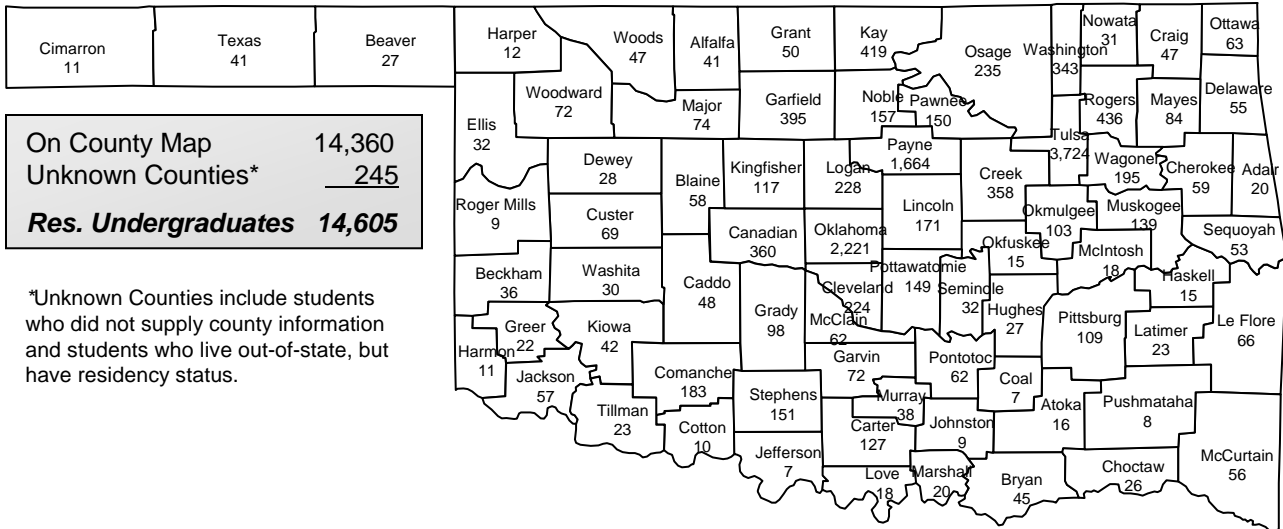

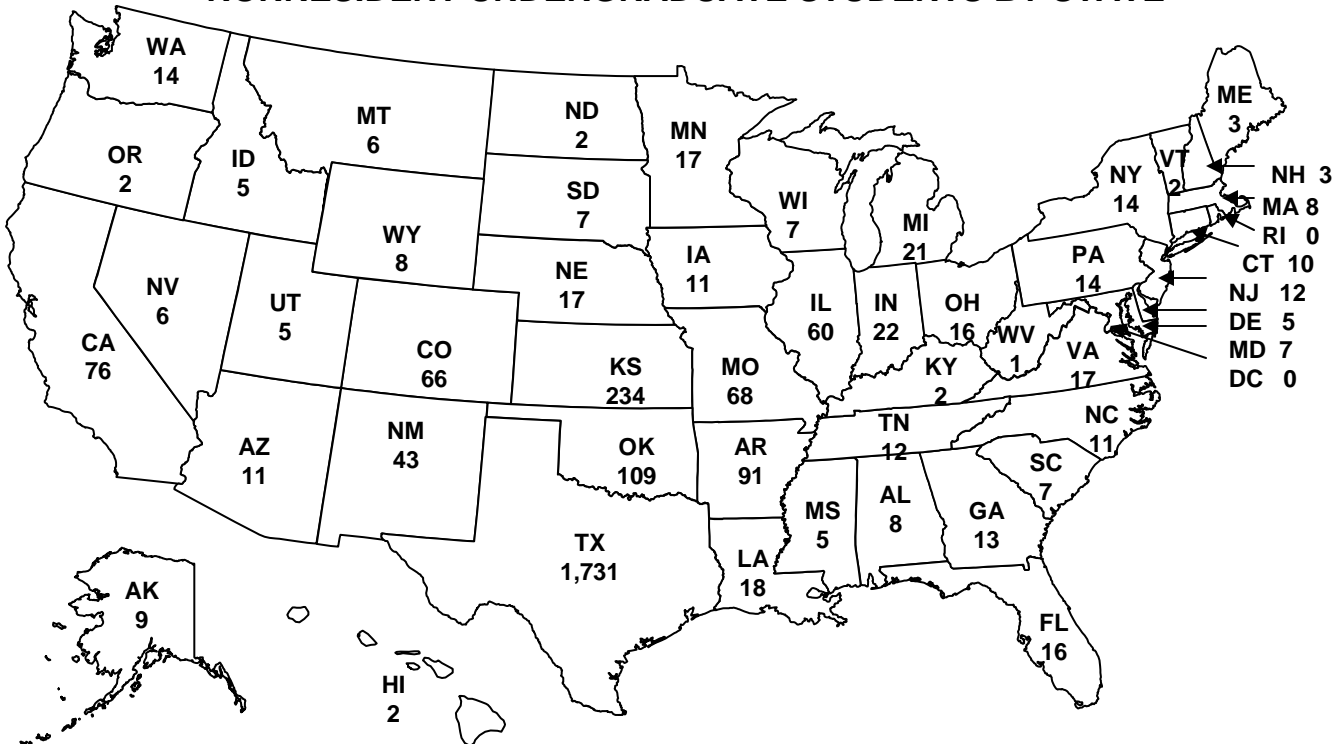

NONRESIDENT UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS BY STATE



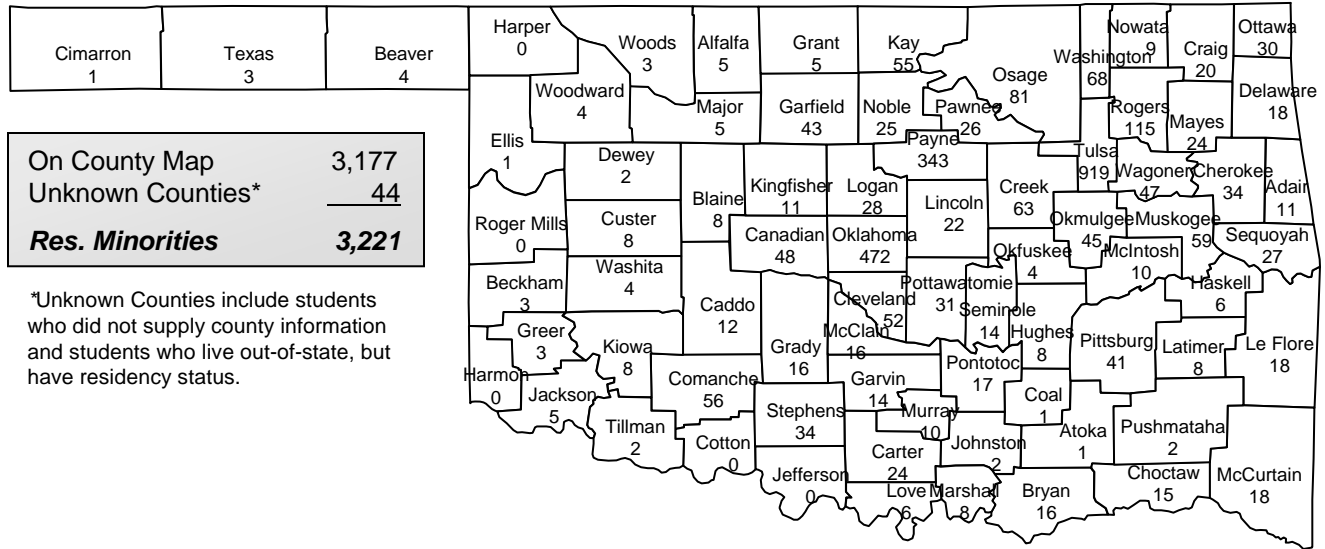

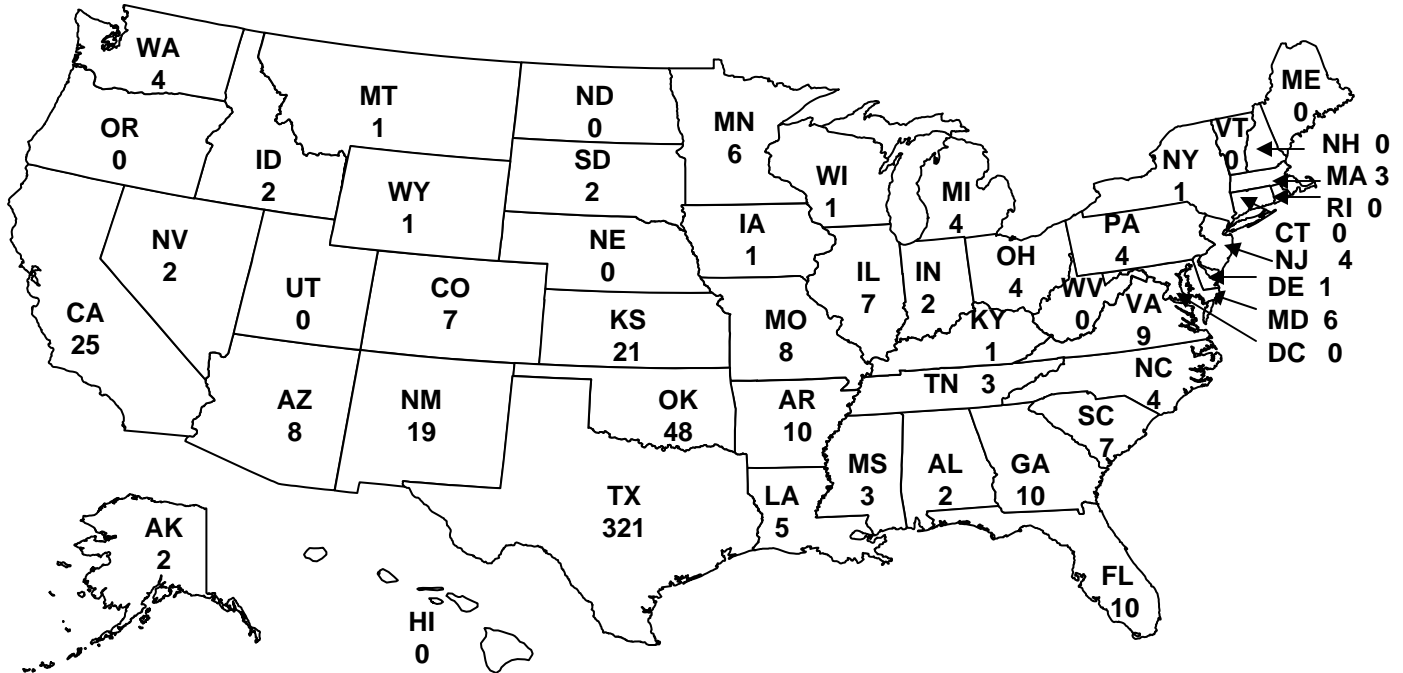
